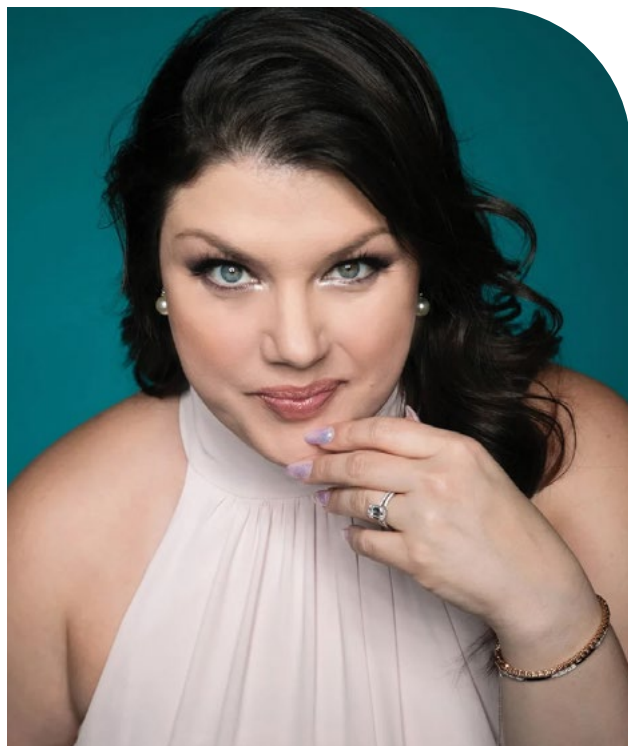


Kathy Griffin New Face, New Tour

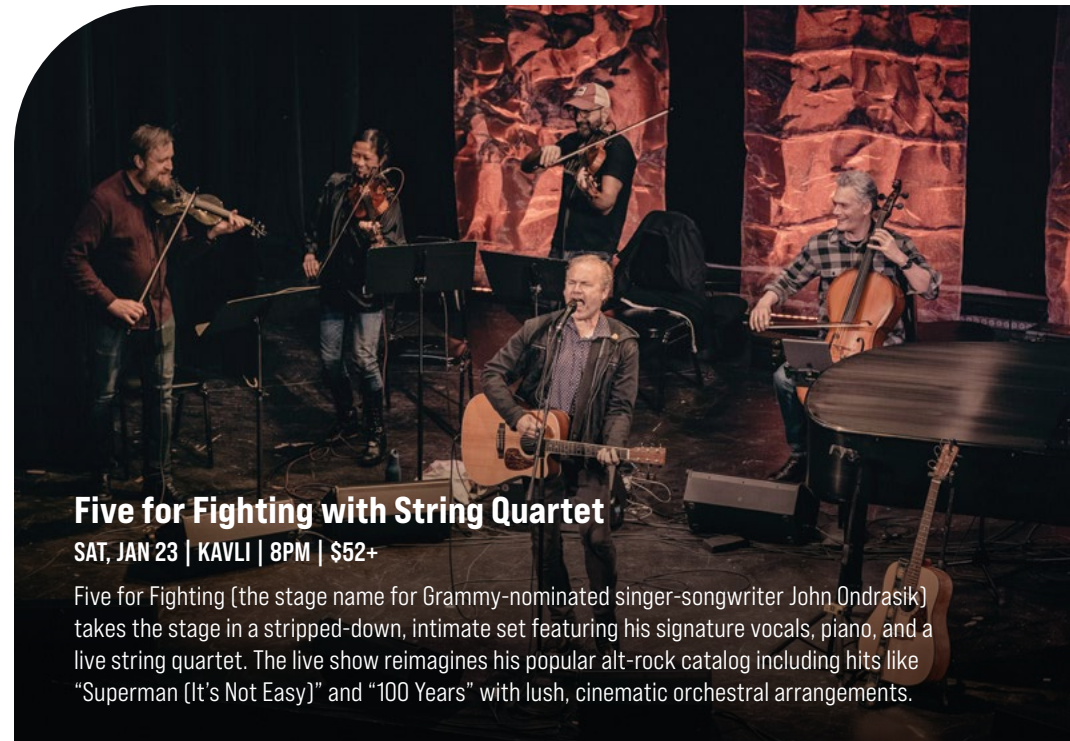

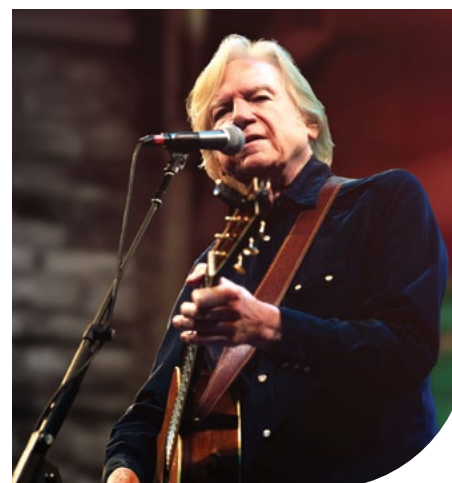

LISTENING DEVICES

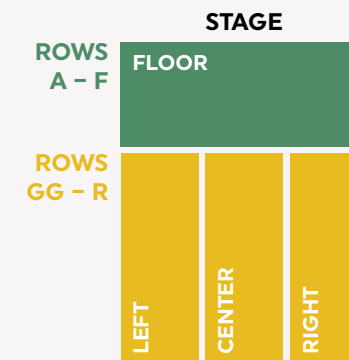
For most performances, headsets which
