The Bank of America Performing Arts Center is part of the Thousand Oaks Civic Arts plaza and is conveniently located off the 101 Ventura Freeway, between the Hampshire Road and Rancho Road exits on Dallas Drive. A six-level parking structure provides ample parking adjacent to the theatres. Parking fee is currently \$15.

### ACCESSIBILITY

Both theatres are fully accessible to persons with disabilities. Wheelchair locations are available in various areas of both theatres. 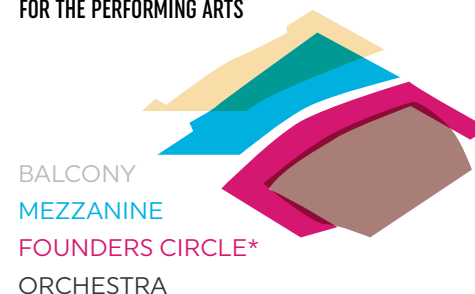

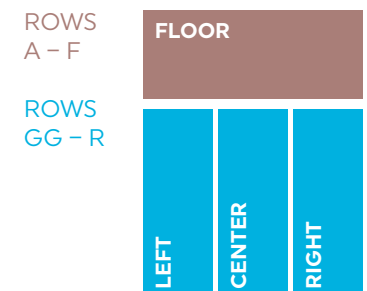
